

Ordinance #380

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #377 BY INSERTING ADDITIONAL WORDING TO SECTIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Montezuma adopted Ordinance #377 regulating Pool Rooms, Game Rooms and Billiard Halls on April 13, 2010,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend said Ordinance by inserting additional wording.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Montezuma, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, that Ordinance #377 be amended by adding additional wording to each section, as follows:

Section 4. Grounds for refusal of license. Add:


**(c) Having had any license issued by the City of Montezuma revoked in the past.**

Section 8.


All coin-operated game machines of any kind, all billiard tables and pool tables, whether coin operated or not, and all rooms containing one or more of any such machines or tables, shall be open to view and accessible to the public, and shall not be placed in a private room or any portion of the business closed off to the public or to the rest of the building by doors or partitions of any kind. All coin-operated amusement machines, billiard tables, and pool tables shall be subject to electronic visual surveillance at all times. Videotapes, DVDs or any other recording shall be maintained for a period of not less than 30 days. **Each business shall be allowed to have a maximum of two (2) coin-operated game machines.**
