

**ORDINANCE #323**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR & COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEZUMA, GEORGIA TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MONTEZUMA, CHAPTER 21, SECTIONS 113 & 114 BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPHS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Montezuma, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by authority of same that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Montezuma, Georgia, be, and the same is hereby amended by adding two additional paragraphs to Chapter 21, Section 113 and 114 as follows:

Chapter 21, Section 113, add

- ( c ) The only exclusion to said discharge requirements of paragraph ( a ) of this section is recognized in Section 21-114 due to AgriLink Foods, Inc.'s capital contribution for modifications to the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant #2. Said modifications allow variations from concentration limits typically considered residential or domestic in origin.

Chapter 21, Section 114, add

( b ) In recognition of the special business arrangement between the City and AgriLink Foods, Inc. regarding the City wastewater treatment plant #2 and in view of the current regulation of the Georgia Water Quality Control Act, the Federal Clean Water Act, and 40 CFR Part 403 General Pretreatment Regulations, and considering the compatible character of the food processing wastewater discharged from AgriLink Foods, Inc, the City hereby agrees to accept wastewater from AgriLink Foods, Inc. in conformance with State and Federal Regulations with the following characteristics:

BOD effluent limitations are to be expressed in pounds/day as opposed to units of concentration based on the variability of effluent discharge flows and wastewater characteristics, and fluctuations in productions schedules.
