

ORDINANCE #332

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR & COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEZUMA, GEORGIA TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MONTEZUMA, APPENDIX A (PERSONNEL) CHAPTER 6 (ATTENDANCE, LEAVE & HOLIDAYS), SECTION 100 (TYPES OF LEAVE), SUB-SECTION 2C (SICK LEAVE, MAXIMUM ACCUMULATION)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Montezuma, Georgia and it is hereby ordained by authority of same that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Montezuma, Georgia, Appendix A, Chapter 6, Section 100, Sub-section 2c be amended by deleting this section in its entirety and inserting a new section, as follows:

Existing
c. Maximum accumulation. Sick Leave may not be accrued in excess of seven hundred twenty (720) hours. Personnel working more or less than forty (40) hours per week will have this maximum amount prorated. Employees will not be paid for accumulated sick leave upon separation.
New
c. Maximum accumulation. Sick Leave may not be accrued in excess of seven hundred twenty (720) hours. Personnel working more or less than forty (40) hours per week will have this maximum amount prorated. Employees will not be paid for accumulated sick leave upon separation <i>except if separation is due to retirement or reduction in force lay off.</i>

SO ORDAINED, BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL of the City of Montezuma, Georgia this 13th day of November, 2001. This Ordinance becomes effective upon passage.
